I would like to pen down a few words about my college. Our College belongs to Mahatma Gandhi Shikshan Mandal, Chopda which has rich academic tradition in chopda Dist Jalgaon (M.S.). Arts, Science and Commerce College, Chopda was established in 1969. The College is affiliated the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon (M.S.). The College is grant in aided by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under 2(f) and 12(B). As an important rural educational centre, presently the college consists of Junior (Arts, Sci., Comm. and M.C.V.C.) and senior college wings with UG (B.A., B.Com, B.Sc., B.B.A., B.C.A.) PG (M.A., M.Com., M.Sc., and M.B.M.), Research and career oriented courses. It caters to the educational needs of students dwelling in rural areas around Chopda taluka.

The teachers use learner-centric teaching-learning methods to cater to the diversity in the aptitudes, intelligence, learning styles and interests of the students. They use non-traditional teaching methods and tools in ICT.

At present education is undergoing a sea change and it is quite understandable that it becomes difficult to make decisions about which course to choose. So, our college is intensely engaged with career counselling cell promoting 'Earn and Learn' project to provide employment opportunity to our college students. Students are also felicities with campus interviews, where they get hands on experience to face interview boldly and seek job employment in leading corporate companies, banks etc.

During the last two decades, the college has taken a giant leap in introducing conventional, vocational, Career and job-oriented programmers at UG, PG and Research levels benefiting thousands of students and empowering a large number of rural students. The vertical and horizontal expansion of the college campus into an academic centre of excellence has put our college on educational map of the state.

We are taking every step to strengthen our supremacy in academic and research programmers, infrastructure, placements, extension co-curricular and extracurricular activities.

About the College

Mahatma Gandhi Shikshan Mandal's Arts, Science and Commerce College Chopda was established in 1969 by Hon'ble Dadasaheb Dr. Suresh G. Patil (Ex MLA) and former Education Minister Late Sau. Sharachchandrika Suresh Patil, to disseminate value-based education and uplift the vocational skills of rural masses for their holistic development. The college was established in response to the dire needs of the young generation of peasants and the landless workers, and poor and downtrodden inhabitants of the region, who instead of academic brilliance had no hope for higher education. The college fulfils its mission of creating an educational environment for the spiralling development of such people under the scholarly guidance of the pioneers, President and Management, Principal, Teaching, Nonteaching staff and with proper representation of students in various committees and activities.

The College is permanently affiliated to the Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The College is a premier academic institution in this region, located in 36 acres sprawling campus. The serene campus of the college provides students with conducive environment for study and such an environment automatically turns students to learning with full concentration and devoid of diversions. The campus beautification is maintained through lawns and planting various trees on the campus. Large number of trees have been planted to conserve the natural beauty and environment of the campus, for which the college was conferred with the "Vanashree Award" in the year 2011 by Government of Maharashtra.

The College provides various under-graduate and post-graduate programs in the faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce. The college began with few students. Today almost 2500 students registered for various UG and PG courses in the faculties of the Arts, Science and Commerce. The College is recognized as Research Centre by the university. The college has well to do infrastructure and ICT facilities for effective curriculum delivery. The Institution has learned and highly qualified faculty members at who are experts in their respective subjects discharging their duties with a sense of dedication and devotion.

Infrastructure and Facilities

Building Blocks:

The college has a spacious and well-equipped building in its natural surroundings. It has buildings like Raigad, Pratapgad (Office), Sahyadri, Saraswati (Library), Devagiri (Gymkhana), Torna, Kaveri, Himalaya, Janjira, Satpuda, Vijaydurg (Consumer Store), etc. It has updated ladies' room, rest room for female students etc. There is an arrangement. CCTV cameras have been installed in the entire campus (all the buildings).

Library Facility:

The college Library Building Block named as "Saraswati", is spacious and well-ventilated. Library hosts a collection of 59,395 books and textbooks, 97000 + e-books, 6000 + e-journals, 54 periodicals, and 305 CD's/DVD's/Video contents. The library has four Reading rooms one for staff and three for students that have an adequate capacity where users can seat and study comfortably at the same time. The library provides good number of online learning resources such as INFLIBNET, Shodhganga, Shodhsindhu, Shodhgangotri, N-list, NPTEL, JSTOR, National Digital Library of India and computers with internet facility for students and teachers.

The library is the prime learning resource of the college and is fully automated through Integrated Library Management System(ILMS) designed by Vriddhi Software team of Hindustan Computer Limited, Malegaon (Maharashtra, India). Vriddhi Software is an ISO 9001-2015 certified. College Library is fully automated from the year 2015 as a post accreditation measure. The Library Management Software consists of modules such as Masters, Book Management, Barcode Facility, Book Accession, Membership, Circulation, OPAC, Catalogues, and Administration etc. The software is having additional features such as members' photograph, can be seen while issuing the books. Book reservation facility, the status of a book such as withdrawn / write-off /damaged/lost and paid, can easily be located. Facilities like database backup restore facility and book bank facility for the students is made available

The library is a knowledge resource centre of college and provides adequate services to its user. Library has collection of 59,395 books (Senior College 59,395 + Book Bank 3634 + Competitive Exam Library 420+ CD/DVD 305) and 54 periodicals/journals. Library fulfils the need of researchers, teachers, students and other staff members of the college community. Library also serves to the outsider users through Library for Society Scheme. The library has sections like; book stacking, periodicals, reference,

reprography, technical processing, circulation, and digital library. Library and reading hall have adequate capacity. All the books have been classified with the Colon Classification System Developed by S.R. Rangnathan. Circulation of books is done by using Vriddhi software. OPAC facility is made available to the users. A special dedicated web OPAC tab is made available on the institution website's

home page. The library is having the membership of INFLIBNET consortia. The Library provides electronic Videos on various disciplines. Library has downloaded more than 2000 e-videos from e-PG Pathshala, Swayam Prabha & NPTEL. N-list provides access to 6,000+ e-Journals and 97,000+ e-Books. The special dedicated is made available at website having https://www.mgsmasc.ac.in/lib_intro.php. All books are equiped with barcoding and accession is done through automation software. The library offers various services to its users like automated circulation system, online public access catalogue, reprography, internet browsing, library orientations, inter-library loan facility, book bank facility, newspaper clipping and selective dissemination of information etc.

Laboratories:

Total 34 Laboratories of the college are fully equipped with advanced equipments. Each department has its own computing facility with the requisite software to meet their own requirements for carrying out academic and research works. In addition to the regular curriculum, students are encouraged to pursue their study/project work in the emerging areas of research. 7 laboratories of the institute (Chemistry, Physics, Electronics, Zoology, Botany, Geography and Biotechnology) are recognized as PostGraduate and Research study Centres by KBC NMU, Jalga

Language Laboratory:

For enriching the communicative abilities of the students the college has made available Advanced Digital Language Laboratory with interactive language lab software from iTell – Orell Digitial (ODLL), Kochi, India.

Computing Equipments:

The college has 250 computers in all, out of these 234 computers are for the educational use for the students and the faculty. The college has provided printers with scanning and Xerox facility to each department in order to facilitate effective ICT enabled teaching learning process. All the departments and computer labs are connected with more than 100 Mbps bandwidth and Wi-Fi. Computer labs, language lab, browsing center, various software, and tools are available for facilitating the teaching and learning process.

Sports Facilities (Indoor and outdoor)

The Department of Physical Education and Sports was established in 1969 which provides excellent sports facilities and fully equipped Gymkhana, fitness zone for the all-round development of the students. Gymnasium houses modern equipments like Double Bar, Chin up Bar, Weighing Machine, Elliptical Cycle, 4, 12, 7 station machine, Power Lifting, and Weight Lifting Sets, Multipurpose Bench,

Single Station Exercise Machine, Gym Mirrors and Weight Plates etc. in its Fitness Zone. UGC sponsored indoor sports facility hall with the furnished Badminton synthetic court. The Zone is open to both students and staff from 6 am to 6 pm. Students are given training in all types of sports to take part in collegiate, intercollegiate, inter-zonal, inter-university, all India inter-University, State, National, and International level competitions. The Director of Physical Education and her team regularly train the students in various games such as Athletics, Badminton, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Volleyball, Table Tennis, Judo, Wrestling, Basket Ball, Pickle Ball etc. To motivate sports players, the college provides incentives like traveling allowance, dearness allowance, sports kits and tracksuits to the winners and participants.

IT Facilities:

The college upgraded its IT facilities including Wi-Fi as per the needs and requirements during the last five years. The college has upgraded internet connection bandwidth from 4 Mbps to 100 Mbps with a campus Wi-Fi facility. The college has updated its IT facilities with increasing the number of computers, printers, scanners, smart boards, interactive LCD projectors, Photocopy machines, online admission process, dynamic website, and various software. The teaching and learning process is enhanced through incorporating ICT tools and e-resources. INFLIBNET, NPTEL online courses, CD's, Video lectures, are exclusively made available to the learners to enhance learning capabilities. The students, teachers and non-teaching staff are also encouraged to use various academic and administrative software's such as Chem draw, R-software, Vriddhi, Edumint, Latex, and Scilab etc.

Cultural Activities:

The college participates in different events like University Youth Festival (Yuvarang), State Level Purushottam Karandak, KBC NMU Ekankika Karandak, Annual Gathering in which students perform plays, mimes, skits, folk dance, folk songs, folk music, western songs, rangoli, art and craft, collage, one act plays, street plays etc. For this participation, students in college are provided with expert trainers from outside agencies. Separate hall has been provided for this purpose. The college has Dolby sound system, amplifier, mikes, musical instruments etc.
